BRS ENHANCED SYSTEM SOFT LAUNCH



THE SOFT LAUNCH

On Thursday 29th June, BRS hosted stakeholders for a soft launch of the enhanced system. The system aims to improve service delivery through end-to-end automation of business processes across the different registries.



AUTOMATION

The Business Process Re-engineering in the system enhancement project entails automation of services for the Official Receiver-17 services, 2 services – Hire Purchase Registry, & 108 services for Companies Registry. 100% of BRS business-facing services will have been automated.

SUPPORT

The project is under Kenya Investment Climate Program Phase 3 that has seen enhancement of automated workflows & automation of manual workflows, as well as execution of an Electronic Document Records Management System.

PILOTING THE ENHANCED SYSTEM

To smoothly achieve this, we have mapped six key components, for there to be a successful pilot as outlined below:

- Development of a plan to onboard participants into the Pilot program;
- Identification of the Mode of execution of the Pilot program;
- Setting timelines for the Pilot program;
- Identification and allocation of resources to facilitate the program;
- Development of a feedback mechanism; and
- Documentation of the final results of the pilot process.
