

How to Clear the Browser's Cache (Microsoft Edge)

1. Loading the Clear Browser's Cache settings page

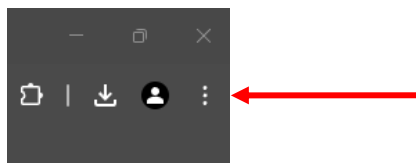


Figure 1 - Loading the 'Settings' Menu

- a. Open the **'Settings'** Menu by clicking on the **three dots** (Fig. 1) situated at the top-right corner of your browser.

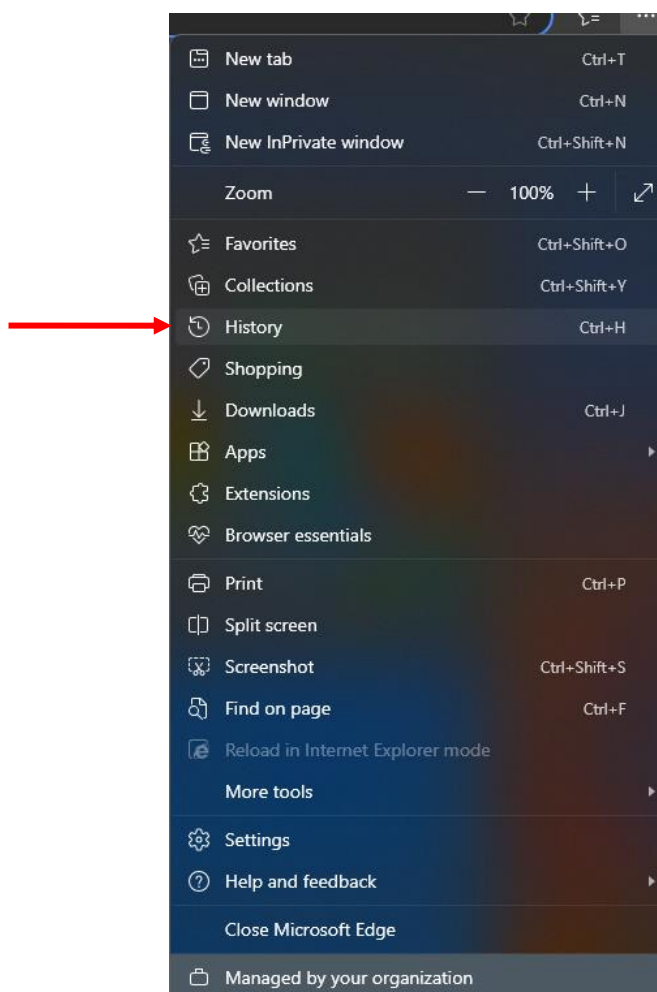


Figure 2 - Selecting 'History'

- b. Hover cursor to **'History'** (Fig. 2).

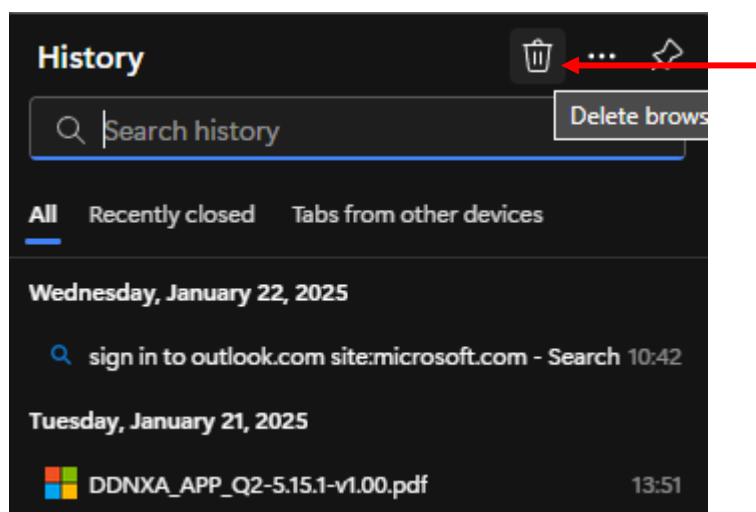


Figure 3 - Select 'Delete browsing data'

2. Click on the marked icon (**Fig. 3**).

3. Clearing browser's cache/data

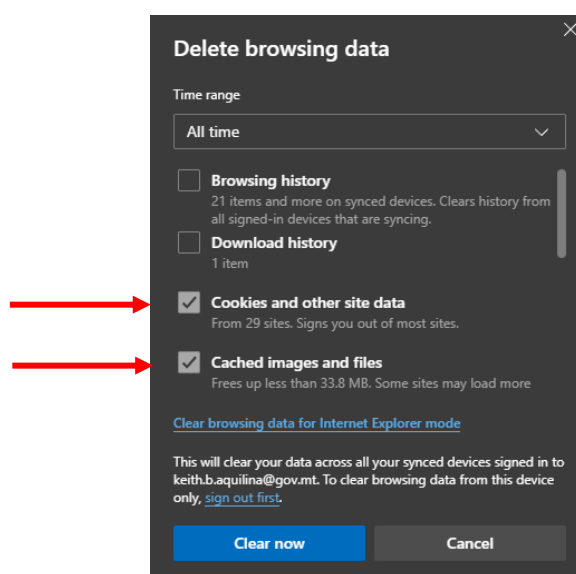


Figure 4 - Cache Selection Criteria

- a. In the following pop-up window that is displayed (**Fig. 4**), select the following criteria:
 - i. **Time Range:** All Time
 - ii. **Cookies and other site data:** Ticked
 - iii. **Cached images and files:** Ticked
 - iv. **Note:** Any other option may be left ticked/unticked based on user's preference.
- b. Click on the '**Delete data**' button.

4. Close Microsoft Edge completely to finish clearing the browser's cache.
5. Re-open Edge and proceed to browse the intended page/solution.
